S130 WILDLAND FIREFIGHTER TRAINING FIELD DAY

March 11, 2017

Rock Island, Illinois

NWCG S130/190, ICS- 100, L-180 CERTIFICATION



This course is the field day portion of the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) S-130 training. Combined with online course completion certificates for NWCG S-130 Firefighter Training, NWCG S-190 Introduction to Fire Behavior, ICS-100 Incident Command System, and NWCG L-180 Human Factors on the Fire line (approximately 36 hours to complete), this field day will complete requirements needed to apply for Wildland Firefighter Type 2 status (commonly called a “red card”). This course will cover the course work training necessary to become certified as an “Illinois Prescribed Fire Manager” under Illinois legislation Public Act 095-0108. The course was previously called S-130/190 prior to online course availability.

How to Participate:

1. Register for the course through River Bend Wildland Trust. Space is limited. Reserve early. A wait list will be kept.
2. **Complete the online course material (S-130 S-190, L-180, and ICS-100) by March 6.**

3. Send an electronic copy of the S-130 completion certificate to RXFire@rbwt.org by midnight on **March 6** to keep your spot in the field day class.
 - **Print all 4 completed certificates and bring to the field day.**
4. Day-of:
 - Registration will take place from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. at Black Hawk State Historic Site in Rock Island, Illinois (details provided with registration)
 - Course will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Lunch and snacks are provided.
 - Weather permitting, a prescribed fire will be conducted. Come prepared with proper PPE and weather gear. Some extra PPE will be available.

INSTRUCTOR: Instructor for the course is Tom Wilson, State Forester, Forest Protection Manager, Illinois Department of Natural Resources

COST: The cost of the course is \$90, which includes snacks and lunch. Discount available for members of the River Bend Wildland Trust. See the registration form for details.
